

### Terms and Conditions Barbados Poker Open Championships

1. The Barbados Federation of Poker Inc. will market and organize a tournament scheduled for August 25<sup>th</sup>-27<sup>th</sup> 2023.
2. The tournament is slated for a maximum of 10 tables which is equivalent to 90 seated players at any given time (excluding the dealers).
3. The organizers will guarantee a Championship Trophy, medals, and at least \$10K to 1<sup>st</sup> place subject to a minimum of 30 players being registered to the tournament.
4. All pre-tournament registrations will be conducted through ticket sales, which have been offered at two (2) levels: \$300 – 4,500 chips and \$500- 10,000 chips. Tickets are available in limited amounts at each level. On commencement of the tournament unlimited re-buys will be allowed up to 3 hours of blind levels. An optional add-on will also be made available for \$200 – 15,000 chips.
5. Should the organizers not reach the required threshold of 30 players, the organizers reserve the right to cancel or amend the tournament.
6. In the case of a cancellation the organizers will issue refunds to all pre-registered players.
7. Once the threshold has been reached, if a pre-registered player is unable to attend/play in the event, a partial refund may be issued at the sole discretion of the organizers. The consideration for the refund will be no greater than 50% of the cost of the ticket.
8. Subject to section 7, should a player be unable to attend/play the event they also have the option of transferring their ticket to a different player. In such circumstances the organizers must be notified of the change prior to the start of the event.
9. Players winning entry through our satellite tournaments have the option of upgrading their ticket by paying the difference.
10. A player who chooses to play in multiple satellites acknowledges that should they win more than one (1) VIP Satellite ticket, they will only be entitled to a cash reimbursement on the value of the seat i.e. \$500.00 less the organizer's administrative fee. Alternatively, they can opt to:
  - Keep the full package
  - Transfer the package to someone else and notify us
  - Keep \$500.00 worth in tickets and surrender the other portion of the package.
11. Players who have not won a VIP Satellite ticket who wish to attend the Opening Ceremony and also play in the Freezeout can make this request to the organizers. The full fee for the opening ceremony and the Freezeout is \$250.00. If a player solely wishes to play in the Freezeout they can do so for \$150.00.

12. Players participating in our event acknowledge their understanding that we will be filming on the days of the tournament and as such agree to a film waiver whereby they may be captured directly or indirectly during the day.

13. Film captured on the day will be used to further advance the growth and education about the sport in Barbados as well as abroad.

14. There will be a "Steam Room/Victory Box" for players to record their sentiments about a hand. This can be done at any time subject to the availability of the room.

15. Players are bound to the rules established by the Barbados Federation of Poker Inc.

16. All rules of the Barbados Federation of Poker Inc. will be fully enforced.

17. The decisions of the organizers are final.

18. All decisions will be made in the spirit of the game. In the case of a dispute the dealer will be the first person to advise on the rules, if a player seeks to further protest the floor manager(s) should be called. In the event that the matter has not been settled the Tournament Director shall be called and his/her decision shall be final once they have consulted with all tournament staff and players if deemed necessary.
